Abridged version of License Agreement

(...)

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. KEY DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this License, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(...)

Archived Materials

The electronic material as set out in Schedule 2 or in new Schedules to this License that may be agreed by the parties from time to time.

Authorized Users

Means the categories of persons associated with Licensee specified in Schedule 1 who have been allowed access to Licenced Material via means of Secure Authentication by Licensee;

Commercial Use

Means use which is for direct or indirect economic or commercial advantage, whether by or for Licensee, Authorised User, or Walk-in User, by means of the sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of Licenced Material.

For the avoidance of doubt:

- (i) use of Licenced Material by Licensee, Authorised Users, or Walk-in Users in the course of research funded by a commercial organisation is not deemed to constitute Commercial Use. However, use of Licenced Material by Licensee, Authorised Users, or Walk-in Users in the course of research funded by a commercial organization for the purpose of contract research is deemed to constitute Commercial Use; and
- (ii) use of Licenced Material by Licensee, Authorised Users, or Walk-in Users in the course of research carried out for a commercial organisation is deemed to constitute Commercial Use;

Course Packs

A collection or compilation of materials (e.g. book chapters, journal articles) assembled by members of staff of the Licensee for use by students in a class for the purposes of instruction.

Electronic Reserve

Electronic copies of materials (e.g. book chapters, journal articles) made and stored on the Secure Network by the Licensee for use by students in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by the Licensee to its students.

Walk-in Users

Means persons who are not Authorised Users but who are registered as permitted users of Licensee's library or information services and who have been allowed access to Archived Material by Licensee via means of Secure Authentication. For the avoidance of doubt, the payment of a fee in order to be registered as a Walk-in User is deemed not to constitute Commercial Use;

2. AGREEMENT

2.1 The Publisher agrees to grant to the Licensee the non-exclusive and non-transferable right to give Authorized Users access to the Archived Materials via a Secure Network for the purposes of research, teaching and private study, subject to the terms and conditions of this License (...).

3. USAGE RIGHTS

3.1 The Licensee, subject to clause 6 below, may:

3.1.1 Allow Authorized Users to have access to the Archived Materials from the Server via the Secure Network.

3.1.2 Provide, or permit the Representative to provide, Authorized Users with integrated access and an integrated author, article title, abstract, and keyword index to the Archived Material and all other similar material licensed from other publishers.

3.1.3 Provide printed or electronic copies of single articles at the request of individual Authorized Users.

3.1.4 Display, download or print the Archived Materials for the purpose of internal testing or for training Authorized Users or groups of Authorized Users.

3.2 Authorized Users may, subject to clause 6 below:

3.2.1 Search, view, retrieve and display the Archived Materials.

3.2.2 Electronically save parts of the Archived Materials for personal use.

3.2.3 Print off single copies of parts of the Archived Materials.

3.2.4 Distribute single copies of parts of the Archived Materials in print or electronic form to other Authorized Users.

4. SUPPLY OF COPIES TO OTHER LIBRARIES

4.1 The Licensee may, subject to clause 6 below, supply to an Authorized User of another site specified in Schedule 4, a single paper copy of an individual document being part of the Archived Materials by post, fax or electronic transmission via the Internet or otherwise, for the purposes of research or private study and not for Commercial Use.

5. PRINTED COURSE PACKS AND ELECTRONIC RESERVE

5.1 The Licensee may, subject to clause 6 below, incorporate parts of the Archived Materials in printed Course Packs and Electronic Reserve collections for the use of Authorized Users in the course of instruction at the Licensee's institution. Each such item shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source, listing title and author of the extract, title and author of the work, and the publisher. Electronic copies of such items shall be deleted by the Licensee when they are no longer used for such purpose. Course packs in non-electronic non-print perceptible form, such as audio or Braille, may also be offered to Authorized Users who, in the reasonable opinion of the Licensee, are visually impaired.

6. PROHIBITED USES

6.1 The Licensee may not:

6.1.1 intentionally remove or alter the authors' names or the Publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Archived Materials;

6.1.2 systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts of the Archived Materials for any purpose other than for printed Course Packs and electronic reserves under 5.1;

6.1.3 mount or distribute any part of the Archived Material on any electronic network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than the Secure Network and through other networks for interlibrary lending.

6.2 The Publisher's permission must be obtained in order to:

6.2.1 use all or any part of the Archived Materials for any Commercial Use;

6.2.2 systematically distribute the whole or any part of the Archived Materials to anyone other than Authorized Users;

6.2.3 publish, distribute or make available the Archived Materials, works based on the Archived Materials, or works which combine them with any other material, other than as permitted in this License.
