Abridged version of License Agreement 2012-2014

[...]

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS

§ 1 Definitions

1. In this Licence Agreement, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(...)

- b. **Authorised Users:** individuals who are authorised by the Institution to access the Institution's information services whether on-site or off-site via Secure Authentication and who are affiliated to the Institution as a current student (including but not limited to undergraduates, postgraduates and guest students), member of staff (whether on a permanent or temporary basis including retired members of staff and any teacher who teaches Authorised Users) or contractor or registered user of the Institution. Persons who are not currently a student, member of staff, contractor or registered user of the Institution, but who are permitted to access the Institution's information services from computer terminals or otherwise within the physical premises of the Institution ["Walk-In Users"] are also deemed to be Authorised Users, only for the time they are within the physical premises of the Institution.

Only for full national licences or shallow backfiles: Authorised User means as well any individual subject to the requirement of permanent residence in Germany that has completed a suitable registration procedure as long as such registration remains in effect.

- b. **Commercial Use:** the use of the Licensed Material for the purpose of monetary reward (whether by or for the Institution or an Authorised User) by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Material. For the avoidance of doubt, neither recovery of direct costs by the Institution or the use by the Institution or Authorised Users of the Licensed Material in the course of research funded by a commercial organisation, is deemed to constitute Commercial Use.

The use of Metadata in search engines does not constitute Commercial Use as long as that Metadata is not sold, lent, distributed or otherwise re-licensed via that search engine or the access to that Metadata on that search engine is not being charged for.

- c. **Educational Purposes:** The use for the purpose of education, teaching, distance learning, private study and/or research.

§ 3 Permitted uses

1. The Licensee and the Institutions may:

(...)

- b. Provide Authorised Users with an integrated access and index to the Licensed Material and all other similar material licensed from other publishers. The Licensed Material or

parts thereof may be indexed and catalogued (including, without limitation, the header data and abstracts) by the Licensee and the Institutions for non-Commercial Use. Anything thereby created may be integrated into the products and services of the Institutions for non-Commercial Use. Notwithstanding the above-mentioned rights the use of Licensed Material shall be limited to Authorised Users

- c. The Licensed Material may be used to perform and engage in textmining/data mining activities, including but not limited to full text indexing provided such textmining /data mining is carried out only by the Licensee or an Institution within the Licensee's or Institution's Secure Network only. Notwithstanding the above-mentioned rights the use of Licensed Material shall be limited to Authorised Users.
- d. supply to the library of an institution within the same country as the Licensee or Institution (whether by post, fax or secure transmission, using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted immediately after printing), for the purposes of individual research or private study by an Authorised User of the library and not for Commercial Use, a single paper copy of an individual document forming part of the Licensed Material (...);
- e. allow each Authorised User to download the Licensed Materials to a maximum of 5 hand held devices for their personal use (...). Notwithstanding the above, whilst the Publisher permits the use detailed in this sub-clause (e), the Licensee, the Institutions and Authorised Users acknowledge that the Publisher makes no warranty as to the Licensed Material's suitability for or use by the Licensee, Institutions and Authorised Users in the event that the Licensed Materials do not function properly or at all on such hand held devices.
- f. Display, download and print parts of the Licensed Material for the purpose of promotion of the Licensed Material, testing of the Licensed Material, or for training of Authorised Users;
- g. Make such copies of training material and network such training material as may be required for the purpose of using the Licensed Material in accordance with this Licence Agreement;
- h. Allow Authorised Users to (...):
 - Access the Licensed Material by Secure Authentication in order to search, retrieve, display and view the Licensed Material for personal use only;
 - Electronically save individual articles or items of the Licensed Material;
 - Incorporate parts of the Licensed Materials in printed course packs, study packs, resource lists and/or in virtual and managed environments (including but not limited to virtual learning environments, managed learning environments, virtual research environments and library environments) to be used by Authorised Users at an Institution and hosted on a Secure Network. Each such item shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source, listing title and author of the extract, title and author of the work, copyright notice, and the publisher. Copies of such items shall be deleted by the Authorised User when they are no longer used for such purpose. Course packs in non-electronic non-print perceptible form, such as Braille, may also be offered to Authorised Users who, in Licensee's reasonable opinion, are visually impaired;
 - Incorporate parts of the Licensed Materials in printed or electronic form in assignments and portfolios, theses and in dissertations ("the Academic Works"), including reproductions of the Academic Works for personal use and library deposit. Reproductions in printed or electronic form of Academic Works may be provided to sponsors of such Academic Works. Each item shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source;
 - Publicly display parts of the Licensed Materials as part of a presentation at a

seminar, conference, or workshop, or other such similar activity (...);

- copy and paste parts of the Licensed Materials for personal use only
- make a reasonable number of printed copies of parts of the Licensed Materials for personal use only

§ 4 Restrictions

1. Save as provided herein, Licensee, the Institutions and Authorised Users may not:
 - a. Sell or resell the Licensed Material unless the Licensee, an Institution or an Authorised User has been granted prior written consent by the Publisher to do so;
 - b. Remove, obscure or modify copyright notices, text acknowledgment or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear on the Licensed Materials;
 - c. Engage in systematic copying or downloading of the Licensed Materials, or transmit any part of the Licensed Materials by any means to anyone who is not an Authorised User, except as otherwise provided herein;
 - d. Alter, adapt or modify the Licensed Material, except to the extent necessary to make it perceptible on a computer screen, or as otherwise permitted in this Licence Agreement. For the avoidance of doubt, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted;
 - e. Display, mount or distribute any part of the Licensed Material on any electronic network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web, and any other distribution medium now in existence or hereinafter created, unless otherwise permitted in this Licence Agreement under Local Hosting;
 - f. Use all or any part of the Licensed Material for any Commercial Use or for any purpose other than Educational Purposes.
 - g. Allow copies to be stored or accessed by anyone who is not an Authorised User, except as otherwise provided herein;
 - h. Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or otherwise alter software;
 - i. Make the Licensed Material available in any other form or medium or create derivative works without the written permission of the Publisher. 2. The Publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:
 - a. use all or any part of the Licensed Materials for any Commercial Use;
 - b. distribute the whole or any part of the Licensed Materials to anyone other than Authorised Users;
 - c. publish, distribute or make available the Licensed Materials, works based on the Licensed Materials or works which combine them with any other material, other than as permitted in this Licence Agreement.
