### TERMS & CONDITIONS

#### 2.1.3 Text & Data Mining

Licensee, its Affiliates and the Authorized Users may use the licensed data for text and data mining, namely downloading, extracting and indexing information from the Licensed Materials, for text and data mining purposes and mounting, loading and integrating the results of text and data mining on servers used for the Licensee's text and data mining systems, as well as evaluating and interpreting the text and data mining output, for access and use by Authorized Users only. Text and data mining may be undertaken on either locally loaded Licensed Materials or as mutually agreed. Such text and data mining is permitted for internal, research purposes only and the outputs from such text and data mining may not be sold, licensed, assigned, transferred, or disposed of in any way, or otherwise disclosed to any third party.

#### Authorised Users:

"Authorised Users" are defined as faculty, staff, researchers, guest scientists and students or users affiliated with the Licensee in some other capacity whereby they are permitted by the Licensee to access such services as are available to faculty, staff, researchers, guest scientists and students, whether from a computer or terminal on the Licensee's secure network or offsite via a modern link to the secure network, as well as users at terminals located in the library facilities of the campuses of the Max Planck Society.

### LICENSED RIGHTS

(...)

**Use via open proxies and other non-authenticated proxy servers is prohibited.**

#### Use of Licensed Materials:

The Licensed Materials may be used by Authorised Users for the purposes of research, teaching and private study only.

#### Copying –transmission:

Authorised Users may retrieve, display, download and print out copies of individual articles or other individual items from the Licensed Materials, but shall be subject to the Terms of use as set out in the Copyright Policy.

Each copy of the Licensed Materials (or any part thereof) shall carry an appropriate acknowledgement of the authors, journal, year, volume, issue, page citation and publisher.

By purchasing a subscription and by using the Licensed Materials or otherwise using the journals and websites of the Company of Biologists or any services accessible from the websites the Licensee is agreeing to be bound by the Terms of Use as set out in the Copyright Policy.

### USAGE RESTRICTIONS Inter-library lending

The Licensed Materials may not be used for any fee-for-service, systematic supply or distribution of the journals in any form or any similar commercial activity to anyone other than an Authorised User.

Subject to the Terms of Use as set out in the Copyright Policy the Licensee is permitted to supply to the user of another library (whether by post, fax or secure intermediate electronic transmission, using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted immediately after printing), for the purposes of research or private study, a single paper copy of an

electronic original of an individual article forming part of the Licensed Material.

## **PROHIBITED USES**

### **Authorised Users may not:**

Remove or alter the author's name(s) or the publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or any and all disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Materials;

Systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts or make multiple copies of any part of the Licensed Materials for any purpose other than that permitted by this Licence;

Prepare derivative works or download, mount or distribute any part of the Licensed Material on any electronic system or network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than the Licensee's secure network approved in advance by the Company of Biologists, except where expressly permitted under this Licence;

Alter, abridge or otherwise modify the Licensed Materials or any part of them for any purpose whatsoever.
