Authorized Users:

Mary Ann Liebert, Inc. publishers grants to the Customer the non-exclusive and non-transferable right for Authorized Users to access to the licensed Publications.

Authorised Users are defined as employees, faculty, staff and students who are officially affiliated with the Customer, and persons affiliated with remote sites or campuses of the Customer that are administered from the Customer's site or campus (but not persons affiliated with remote sites or campuses with a separate administrative staff). Authorised Users may also include users from the general public who are permitted by the Subscribing Institution to access the Journals from designated terminals within the Subscribing Institution's IP ranges.

3. Permitted Use

A. The Customer and Authorized Users are permitted online access to the Licensed Material and may download, save, or print search results of a reasonable portion of the Licensed Material solely for the purposes of research, education or other non-commercial use.

B. The electronic form may be used as a source for Inter-Library Loan in compliance with Section 108 of the United States Copyright Law (17 USC §108, "Limitations on exclusive rights: Reproduction by libraries and archives") and the Guidelines for the Proviso of Subsection 108(2g)(2) prepared by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works (CONTU).

Text Mining:

Authorized Users may use the Licensed Materials to perform and engage in text and/or data mining activities for academic research, scholarship, and other educational purposes, utilize and share the results of text and/or data mining in their scholarly work, and make the results available for use by others, so long as the purpose is not to create a product for use by third parties that would substitute for the Licensed Materials.

4. Prohibitions on Certain Uses

A. Customer may not remove, obscure or modify any copyright or other notices included in the Licensed Material.

B. Altering, recompiling, systematic or programmatic copying, reselling, redistributing, publishing or republishing the Journal content or any part thereof without explicit permission from the copyright holder is prohibited.

C. Systematic downloading (e.g., spidering), service bureau redistribution services, printing for "fee-for-service" purposes and/or the systematic making of electronic copies for transmission to non-subscribers are prohibited.

D. Downloading of the Licensed Material, or parts thereof, to form a persistent local archive

is prohibited.

E. Sell or offer fee-for-service use of the Licensed Material.

7. Copyright

Copyright in the Licensor's Journals and their contents, including the abstracts, is vested in the Licensor, whose proprietary and publishing rights are protected under national and international law. Content within the Licensor's Journals that is made available under a Creative Commons or other open license shall be governed by the provisions of that license. Neither Authorized Users nor the Customer shall have any proprietary right in any of the Journals by reason of their access to them.
