Authorised Users. Authorised Users are defined as being those members of faculty or staff, either permanent, temporary, contract or visiting, or students, or other permitted persons.

Copy Restrictions. The Works are the subject of copyright. The Customer will be held legally responsible for any copyright infringement, which is caused or encouraged by failure to abide by the terms of these Terms and Conditions. Subject to these restrictions, a single copy of the Works subscribed to may be made, for the purpose of backing up, maintenance of service and archiving. Copies of single articles or chapters may also be made for internal purposes only, such as course-work or training, but not complete publications. Inter-Library Loan, performed electronically, may also be made solely on a non-commercial one-off basis.

Use Restrictions.
