Abridged version of License Agreement

### IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

#### 1. KEY DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this License, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(...)

**Authorized Users** The Publisher acknowledges and agrees that this is a global license and will be accessed by Licensee's Authorized Users at various locations worldwide.

"Authorized Users" means any employee, officer or consultant/contractor or outsourcing suppliers of Customer who has authorized access to the Service by use of an assigned Company User ID and password for the sole purpose of providing services to or on behalf of Customer. Customer represents that any such consultant/contractors or outsourcing suppliers shall adhere to the same use and use restrictions as set forth in the Agreement as an employee of Customer and Customer shall be fully responsible for acts or omissions of its consultant/contractors to the same extent as its own employees. Authorized Users may be persons remote from the Licensee's physical location.

**Commercial Use** Use for the purposes of monetary reward (whether by or for the Licensee or an Authorized User) by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials. For the avoidance of doubt, use by the Licensee or by an Authorized User of the Licensed Materials in the course of research, product development and related activity in the normal course of business does not constitute Commercial Use.

#### 3. USAGE RIGHTS

3.1 The Licensee (...) may:

- 3.1.1 Make such temporary local electronic copies by means of cacheing of all or part of the Licensed Materials as are necessary solely to ensure efficient use by Authorized Users and not to make available to Authorized Users duplicate copies of the Licensed Materials.
- 3.1.2 Allow Authorized Users to have access to the Licensed Materials from the Server via the Secure Network.
- 3.1.3 Provide single printed or electronic copies of single articles at the request of individual Authorized Users.
- 3.1.4 Display, download or print the Licensed Materials for the purpose of internal testing or for training Authorized Users in respect of which appropriate acknowledgement of the source shall be made.
- 3.1.5 At the request and solely for the personal use of individual Authorized Users, create and provide digital copies of single printed articles existing in Licensee's collections of duly purchased print subscriptions from Publisher, or when the Licensed Materials

are unavailable directly from the publisher's website, such as during Internet interruptions or Publisher server downtimes. Any document digitized in accordance with this clause will be considered part of the Licensed Materials named elsewhere in the license.

- 3.1.6 Supply print or electronic copies of individual articles or parts of articles taken from the Licensed Material to individual third parties for medical information purposes only. Copies supplied under this clause must carry without modification copyright notices already incorporated in the Licensed Materials
- 3.1.7 Provide print or electronic copies of the Licensed Materials to national or international regulatory authorities for the purposes of, or in anticipation of, regulatory approval or patent and/or trademark applications or other legal or regulatory purposes in respect of the Licensee's products or services. Copies purchased by the Licensee from Document Delivery vendors or made from Licensee's collections of subscribed journals may also be used for this purpose.
- 3.1.8 Supply print or electronic copies of individual items taken from the Licensed Materials when required by law for use in legal proceedings.
- 3.1.9 Use automated tools such as a federated search engine to search the Licensed Material, to index limited parts and to save the relevant metadata for the duration of the contract, with the sole purpose of directing Authorized Users to the Licensed Materials as per the terms of the License Agreement.
- 3.1.10 Subscriber may use the licensed data for Text and Data Mining (TDM) meaning: download, extract and index information from the Publisher's Content to which the Subscriber has access under this Subscription Agreement. Where required, mount, load and integrate the results on a server used for the Subscriber's text-mining system and evaluate and interpret the TDM Output for access and use by Authorised Users. The Subscriber shall ensure compliance with Publisher's Usage policies, including security and technical access requirements. Text and data mining may be undertaken on either locally loaded Publisher Content or as mutually agreed.

3.2 Authorized Users may, in accordance with the copyright law of the United States and subject to clause 4 below:

- 3.2.1 Search, view, retrieve and display the Licensed Materials,
- 3.2.2 Electronically save parts of the Licensed Materials for personal use only.
- 3.2.3 Print off single copies of parts of the Licensed Materials for personal use.
- 3.2.4 Distribute a single copy of individual articles or items of the Licensed Materials in print or electronic form to other Authorized Users for their personal use.
- 3.2.5 Post single copies of the Licensed Materials on internal servers or websites accessible only to Authorized Users via the Secure Network.
- 3.2.6 Medical Information: The Subscriber and Authorized Users may: Supply print or electronic copies of individual articles or parts of articles taken from the Licensed Material in response to enquiries from third parties for Medical Information purposes. Copies supplied under this clause must carry without modification copyright notices already incorporated in the Licensed Material. This explicitly excludes any use for document delivery services or pay-per-view services or any other replacement of a subscription or a reprint service for marketing/sales purposes. Third parties shall be defined as: healthcare professionals. Medical information is defined as: accurate and relevant information about Eli Lilly, and Company products.

3.3 Nothing in this License shall in any way exclude, modify or affect any of the Licensee's rights under the copyright laws of the United States.

#### **4. PROHIBITED USES**

4.1 Neither the Licensee nor Authorized Users may:

- 4.1.1 remove or alter the authors' names or the Publisher' s copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Materials;
- 4.1.2 except as specifically permitted by clause 3, systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts of the Licensed Materials for any purpose;
- 4.1.3 except as specifically permitted by clause 3, mount or distribute any part of the Licensed Materials on any electronic network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than the Secure Network.

4.2 The Publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:

- 4.2.1 use all or any part of the Licensed Materials for any Commercial Use, except as specifically permitted by clause 3;
- 4.2.2 except as specifically permitted by clause 3, systematically distribute the whole or any part of the Licensed Materials to anyone other than Authorized Users;
- 4.2.3 publish, distribute or make available the Licensed Materials, works based on the Licensed Materials or works which combine them with any other material, other than as permitted in this License;
- 4.2.4 alter, abridge, adapt or modify the Licensed Materials, except to the extent necessary to make them perceptible on a computer screen to Authorized Users. For the avoidance of doubt, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted.
