Abridged version of License Agreement

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. KEY DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this Licence, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(...)

Authorized Users Current members of the staff (whether on a permanent, temporary or contract basis), students, guest scientists, contractors of the Licensee, and other persons with legal access to the Licensee's library collections and facilities onsite who are permitted to access the Secure Network from within the Licensee's Premises or from such other places where Authorized Users undertake their work for the Licensee (including but not limited to Authorized Users' offices and homes) and who have been issued by the Licensee with a password or other authentication together with Walk in users who are permitted to use the Licensee's library and access to the Secure Network but only from computer terminals within the Licensee's premises

Commercial Use Use for the purposes of promotion of a commercial product or for monetary reward (whether by or for the Licensee or an Authorized User) by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials. For the avoidance of doubt, use by the Licensee or by an Authorized User of the Licensed Materials in the course of research, product development and related activity in the normal course of business does not constitute Commercial Use.

Course Packs A collection or compilation of materials e.g. journal articles assembled by members of staff for the purposes of instruction.

Electronic Reserve Electronic copies of materials e.g. journal articles made and stored on the Secure Network by the Licensee for use by students in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by the Licensee to its Students.

Licensee's Premises The physical premises owned or operated by the Licensee (...)

Secure Network A network (whether a standalone network or a virtual network within the Internet) which is only accessible to Authorized Users approved by the Licensee whose identity is authenticated at the time of log-in and periodically

thereafter consistent with current best practice, and whose conduct is subject to regulation by the Licensee.

Text Mining

A machine process by which information may be derived by identifying patterns and trends within natural language through text categorisation, statistical pattern recognition, concept or sentiment extraction, and the association of natural language with indexing terms.

3. USAGE RIGHTS

3.1 The Licensee, subject to clause 4 below, may:

- 3.1.1 Make such temporary local electronic copies by means of cacheing or mirrored storage of all or part of the Licensed Materials as are necessary solely to ensure efficient use by Authorized Users.
- 3.1.2 Provide, or permit the Agent or the Licensee to provide, Authorized Users with integrated access and an integrated author, article title, abstract and keyword index to the Licensed Material and all other similar material licensed from other publishers.
- 3.1.3 Use the Licensed Materials as part of an integrated information service for Authorized Users that will include links between the Licensed Materials and the Licensee's own indexes, third party abstracting and indexing services and other information resources utilised by the Licensee.
- 3.1.4 Provide single printed or electronic copies of single articles at the request of individual Authorized Users.
- 3.1.5 Display, download or print the Licensed Materials for the purpose of internal testing or for training Authorized Users or groups thereof, and for internal corporate training programmes (in respect of which appropriate acknowledgement of the source shall be made).
- 3.1.6 Provide to Authorised Users print copies of the Licensed Materials for use in Course Packs, and provide access to electronic copies of the licensed Materials for use in Electronic Reserve as part of the Licensee's courses of instruction.
- 3.1.7 Provide print or electronic copies of the Licensed Materials to national or international regulatory authorities for the purposes of, or in anticipation of, regulatory approval or patent and/or trademark applications or other legal or regulatory purposes in respect of the Licensee's products or services.
- 3.1.8 Licensee may, subject to clause 4 below, supply to an Authorized User of another library not being the Licensee's (whether by post, fax or secure

transmission, using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted immediately after printing), for the purposes of research or private study and not for Commercial Use, a single paper copy of an electronic original of an individual document being part of the Licensed Materials.

3.2 Authorized Users may, subject to clause 4 below:

- 3.2.1 Search, view, retrieve and display the licensed Materials.
- 3.2.2 Electronically save parts of the Licensed Materials for personal use.
- 3.2.3 Print off single copies of parts of the Licensed Materials.
- 3.2.4 Distribute single copies of parts of the Licensed Materials in print or electronic form to other Authorized Users, including use in Course Packs.
- 3.2.5 Use Text Mining technologies to derive information from the Licensed Materials.

3.3 Nothing in this Licence shall in any way exclude, modify or affect any of the Licensee's rights under the copyright laws of the European Union.

4. PROHIBITED USES

4.1 Neither the Licensee nor Authorized Users may:

- 4.1.1 Remove or alter the authors' names or the Publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Materials;
- 4.1.2 Systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts of the Licensed Materials for any purpose, except as expressly provided in clause 2.4, for local archival preservation purposes, and in clauses 3.1.6, for use in Course Packs and/or Electronic Reserve, and 3.2.4 for Course Packs.
- 4.1.3 Except as provided herein, provide, by electronic means, to a user at another library or elsewhere, a retained electronic copy of any part of the Licensed Materials;
- 4.1.4 Mount or distribute any part of the Licensed Material on any electronic network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web.

4.2 The Publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:

- 4.2.1 Use all or any part of the Licensed Materials for any Commercial Use;

- 4.2.2 Systematically distribute the whole or any part of the Licensed Materials to anyone other than Authorized Users;
- 4.2.3 Publish, distribute or make available the Licensed Materials, works based on the Licensed Materials or works which combine them with any other material, other than as permitted in this Licence;
- 4.2.4 Alter, abridge, adapt or modify the Licensed Materials, except to the extent necessary to make them perceptible on a computer screen or as otherwise permitted in this Licence, to Authorized Users. For the avoidance of doubt, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted.
