SCHEDULE 3 – Usage Rights and Prohibited Uses

USAGE RIGHTS

The Member Organisation, subject to Prohibited Uses below, may:

- Make such temporary local electronic copies by means of cacheing of all or part of the Subscription Content as are necessary solely to ensure efficient use by Eligible Users and not to make available to Eligible Users duplicate copies of the Subscription Content.
- Allow Eligible Users to have access to the Subscription Content from the Server via a secure network.
- Provide Eligible Users with integrated access and an integrated author, article title, abstract and keyword index to the Subscription Content and all other similar material licensed from other publishers.
- Provide single printed or electronic copies of single articles at the request of individual Eligible Users.
- Display, download or print the Subscription Content for the purpose of internal marketing or testing or for training Eligible Users or groups of Eligible Users.
- Search, view, retrieve and display the Subscription Content.
- Print a copy or download and save individual articles or items of the Subscription Content for personal use.
- Use individual parts of the Subscription Content within learning objects for the Member Organisation's teaching, learning or training purposes.
- Use text mining technologies to derive information from the Subscription Content.
- Distribute a copy of individual articles or items of the Subscription Content in print or electronic form to other Eligible Users or to other individual scholars collaborating with Eligible Users but only for the purposes of research and private study; for the avoidance of doubt, this sub-clause shall include the distribution of a copy for teaching purposes to each individual student Eligible User in a class at the Member Organisation's institution.
- Download a copy of individual articles or items of the Subscription Content and share the same with Eligible Users or other individual scholars collaborating in a specific research project with

such Eligible Users provided that it is held and accessibly within a closed network that is not accessible to any person not directly involved in such collaboration and provided that it is deleted from such network immediately upon completion of the collaboration.

- Nothing in this Agreement shall in any way exclude, modify or affect any of the Member Organisation's statutory rights under the copyright laws of Germany.

PROHIBITED USES

Neither the Member Organisation nor Eligible Users may:

- remove or alter the authors' names or the Publisher's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Subscription Content;
- systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts or make multiple copies of any part of the Subscription Content for any purpose other than expressly permitted by this Agreement;
- prepare derivative works or download, mount or distribute any part of the Subscription Content on any electronic system or network, including without limitation the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than the secure network, except where expressly permitted by this Agreement;
- reverse engineer, decompile, alter, abridge or otherwise modify the Subscription Content or any part of them for any purpose whatsoever, except as expressly provided in this Licence.

The Publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:

- use all or any part of the Subscription Content for any Commercial Use;
- systematically distribute the whole or any part of the Subscription Content to anyone other than Eligible Users;
- publish, distribute or make available the Subscription Content, works based on the Subscription Content or works which combine them with any other material, other than as permitted in this Agreement;
- alter, abridge, adapt or modify the Subscription Content, except to the extent necessary to make them perceptible on a computer screen to Eligible Users. For the avoidance of doubt, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted.
